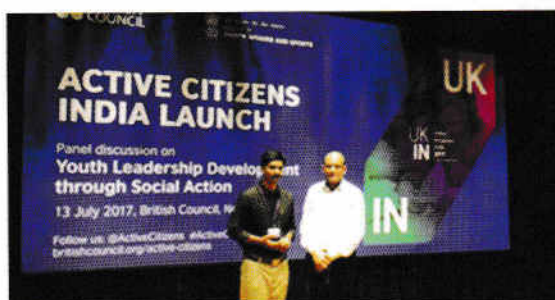

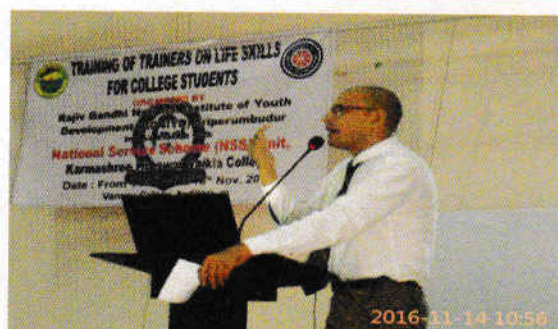


► NSS volunteers participated in Personality Development Programme held in IIE from 19th May to 24th May 2017.
