About the College

Karmashree Hiteswar Saikia College

Karmashree Hiteswar Saikia College is one of the prominent institutions of higher education in Assam, known for its commitment to academic excellence and social development. Since its establishment in 1988, the college has been playing a vital role in imparting quality education to students, especially those from diverse socio-economic backgrounds. Situated at Six Mile, Guwahati, the college offers a peaceful and conducive environment for learning and intellectual development of the students coming from the different parts of the state and Northeast India.

The College Traversing the Course of Time:

With the shifting of the capital of Assam from Shillong to Dispur in 1973, the city of Guwahati witnessed rapid population growth and urban expansion. However, facilities for higher education remained limited, as the existing colleges in the city were unable to accommodate the increasing number of students. As a result, many aspiring learners were deprived of opportunities for higher education.

Recognizing this gap and understanding the urgency of the situation, a group of prominent educationists and social activists envisioned the establishment of a new college in the south-eastern part of Guwahati, near the Assam–Meghalaya inter-state border. Their efforts led to the founding of Karmashree Hiteswar Saikia College, originally established as City College on 19th September, 1988 at the O.B.C. Complex, Dispur. This initiative was spearheaded by late Tholok Gogoi, whose vision was to impart higher education to the downtrodden and underprivileged sections of society.

Late Tholok Gogoi, the founder secretary of the college, was also the General Secretary of the All Assam Other Backwards Classes Association, the “Mantri” of the Assam Rastrabhasha Prachar Samiti, and a dedicated social worker throughout his life. His untiring efforts and commitment to social upliftment played a crucial role in shaping the institution and its mission.

The early years of City College, the dream project of Tholok Gogoi, were marked by severe financial constraints and lack of basic infrastructure. Despite these challenges, the college managed to survive until 1992 without its own land or buildings. A turning point came with the support of Hiteswar Saikia, the then Chief Minister of Assam. Recognizing the need for a higher educational institution in the

south-eastern part of Guwahati, he allotted land at Sixmile, Panjabari Road, during his tenure. The college was subsequently shifted to this new campus on 29th February 1996- the present site of the college.

A new Governing Body was later constituted under the presidentship of Dr. Hemoprava Saikia. Under her dynamic leadership, the institution progressed steadily. In recognition of the immense contribution of Hiteswar Saikia, the college was officially renamed as Karmashree Hiteswar Saikia College on 4th January 2004 at a public meeting attended by eminent citizens, educationists, and students of the state.

Initially, the college offered both Higher Secondary and undergraduate (B.A.) courses. However, in 2000, the Higher Secondary section was separated and shifted to the Karmashree Hiteswar Saikia Secondary School.

Over the years, the college has witnessed steady infrastructure development. The Uma Charan Bania Memorial Library and Education Centre was established on 8th January 2011 through the generous support of the family of Late Uma Charan Bania. A centrally air-conditioned auditorium was inaugurated on 6th May 2016 with assistance from the Government of Assam. On 9th February 2019, Kumud Ch. Deka Memorial open stage was donated by the family of Late Kumud Chandra Deka.

It received permanent affiliation from Gauhati University in 2010 for its Arts stream. It was recognized under Sections 2(f) and 12(B) of the UGC Act, 1956 in 2013, and its Arts stream was provincialized in 2013 by the Government of Assam. Besides, adding another feather to its cap the college started the Commerce stream in 2013 in self-financed mode.

The college also got the first ever NAAC Accreditation in 2022 securing **Grade B**.

The College Today:

Today, the college stands as a growing co-educational institution offering Arts and Commerce courses in a serene academic environment. It runs an array of undergraduate courses in Arts and Commerce. In addition to traditional courses, the college also provides professional and skill-based programmes, cultural and sports facilities for the students. The college has an active NSS (National Service Scheme) unit, a moral and spiritual study centre, different hobby clubs, add on course like Montessori Training Centre, and Tailoring Course. Besides, to facilitate its academic endeavour the college has a KKHSOU study centre that runs both undergraduate and post graduate courses.

The infrastructure of the college supports its academic mission. It has well-equipped classrooms with digital facilities, a digitalized library with a rich collection of books and journals, and an auditorium and open stage for cultural and academic activities. The college also organizes a good number of national and international seminars, conference, lectures, workshops, etc. for enriching its academic contribution and uplifting the students, teachers and the community. These activities help in the holistic development of students by nurturing their talents and building confidence.

An important aspect of the college is its dedication to social responsibility. It has an adopted village named Nam-tepesia in Sonapur locality. The college promotes awareness about environmental issues, social harmony, and community service. Through various initiatives, students are encouraged to engage with society and contribute positively to the community. This reflects the broader vision of education as not just the acquisition of knowledge, but also the development of responsible citizens.

Karmashree Hiteswar Saikia College stands as a symbol of educational progress in Assam. With its dedication to quality education, inclusive growth, and student development, the college continues to shape the future of countless young minds. It remains an important centre of learning, contributing not only to academic advancement but also to the social and cultural enrichment of the region.

The college has been able to carve a niche in the academic ground with its sustained academic engagement, vibrant co-curricular activities, and meaningful outreach initiatives. The faculty members have been ceaselessly striving towards accomplishing their commitment to quality teaching, research, and mentoring, while the students actively participate in academic, cultural, and extension activities, bringing laurels to the college.

The names of the philanthropists like Uma Konwar, Pradip Saikia, Atul Buragohain, etc. were so genuinely associated in the architecture of the college that the strength of the institution became unparalleled at this time.

In this entire period of educational journey, the college was headed by Chambus Gogoi, Dr. Arun Barua, Dr. Ramesh Buragohain, Ananda Buragohain, and Dr. Sikhmoni Konwar and very recently Dr. Budhen Kumar Saikia as Principal of this great seat of higher learning. In 2026, with the inclusion of 15 numbers of skill development courses from Psychological Health to Artificial Intelligence, the college has started a beautiful big jerk for a skillful student-centric growth strategy to stand before the challenging world. To flourish the innate talents of each and every student is also an innovative challenging approach for greater going of the institution.

In this entire 'Holistic' journey, the motto of "Think Global and Act Local" paves the way for facing the challenges of higher education at this present time.

FYUGP BA course structure under Gauhati University as per NEP-2020 Bachelor of Arts (B.A.)

The Four Year Under Graduate Programme (FYUGP) by Gauhati University comprise of altogether 8 final semester examinations. There are also compulsory sessional examinations once in each semester. Only the students having the minimum attendance of 75% of the total classes held are eligible to sit in the final examinations. There is also provision of additional marks of attendance, i.e. 1 mark for 76% to 80%, 2 marks for 81% to 85%, 3 marks for 86% to 90% and 4 marks for 91% to 100% attendance as per G.U. guidelines

ADMISSION PROCESS

The entire admission process for FYUGP B.A. Courses is to be conducted online in the SAMARTH Portal for the academic session 2026-27

Admission Rules:

1. A candidate must upload the following documents at the time of admission.
 - Original Mark Sheets, Admit Cards, Pass Certificate (H.S.L.C. & H.S.)
 - Three copies of recent passport-size photographs.
 - The provisional/original pass certificate from the head of institution last attended.
 - Original caste certificate from the concerned authority. (For ST/SC/OBC/MOBC)
 - Students from the Board other than AHSEC shall have to produce migration certificate at the time of Admission.
 - Admission fees for self-financing classes are to be paid through online transaction.
2. Admission Fees once paid will not be refunded.
3. If a forged document is submitted by a candidate his/her admission will stand cancelled.
4. G.U. Registration forms must be submitted within 10 days of the admission.
5. Students pursuing part time/full time job/other courses or engaged in any other activities will not be allowed to take admission in the regular course of the college.

COLLEGE LIBRARY

Uma Charan Bania Memorial Library and Education Centre

The College library provides an adequate number of textbooks and reference materials which can be borrowed by students on production of identity cards.

A student can borrow two books at a time for 15 days. Books may be reissued for another 15 days. A late fine of Rs. 2.00 shall be levied per day for 15 days, and thereafter Rs. 5.00 per day till the date of return.

The library remains open from 9.00 am to 4 pm on all working days. Books are issued from 10 to 3 pm. The college library has internet facilities for students and for research purposes. The library is digitalized.



COLLEGE AUDITORIUM:

The college has a well-furnished, state-of-the-art, centrally air-conditioned auditorium with a seating capacity of 483.



OPEN-AIR-STAGE:

The college has Kumud Ch. Deka Memorial open-air stage for holding the outdoor cultural and other functions of the college.



COLLEGE CANTEEN/CAFETERIA:

The College has a well-maintained canteen and a cafeteria “Cafe Citian” which are supervised by a canteen committee.



COLLEGE GYMNASIUM (GYM):

The college has a well- maintained gym for students and teachers.

STUDENTS UNION

The College Students' Union is the general body consisting the students of the college. Its membership is compulsory for every student. The office bearers of the Union body are elected annually.

COLLEGE RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The college lays great emphasis on discipline and character building of the students. A student, if found guilty of disobeying college rules, will have to face strict disciplinary action, which includes expulsion from the college/rusticated for a period/debarred from appearing in any examination for one or more years etc. Such disciplinary action will be decided by the * Disciplinary Committee * headed by Principal, and her decision shall be final in all such matters.
2. All forms of ragging in the college campus are strictly prohibited. Anyone found indulging in ragging will be firmly dealt with disciplinary action.
3. Any violation of college rules, unsatisfactory progress, irregular attendance, non-clearance of college dues, discourtesy to faculty members in any form, or adoption of unfair means during examination will be dealt with strictly.
4. Any notice desired to be put up or circulated to students on the college campus will require the prior approval of the college authority.
5. Use of mobile phones in the classrooms is strictly prohibited.
6. Students who fail to attend 75% of total classes held in an academic year are not allowed to appear in any examination. This applies to all the subjects, both Major & Minor.
7. Students must attend all the sessional examinations, failing which he/she shall not be allowed to appear in G.U. Final Examination.
8. Students, along with their Parents/guardians, are requested to be present in the Orientation Day that is to be observed on the 1st day of the new session.
9. The course of study in the college is based as a full-time course. So, no student is allowed to pursue any other course of study simultaneously in another institution.
10. The college is a tobacco-free zone. Use of tobacco in the college premises is strictly prohibited.
11. The college is a plastic-free and environmentally viable zone. Use of plastic in the college premises is strictly prohibited.

IDENTITY CARDS

A non-transferable Identity Card will be issued to every student at the time of admission. The students are required to keep the identity cards with them during college hours and have to be produced whenever demanded. Identity cards are issued annually.

The college regularly organises seminars, conferences, group discussions, and personality development programs where students and faculty are actively involved.

All guardians should keep in contact with the Principal and keep track of the academic progress of their wards. Constructive suggestions from the guardians are most welcome at any time, and they are requested to attend the Parent-Teacher Meet organised by every department of the college from time to time.
