
- Successfully organised a UGC sponsored National Seminar in the college.

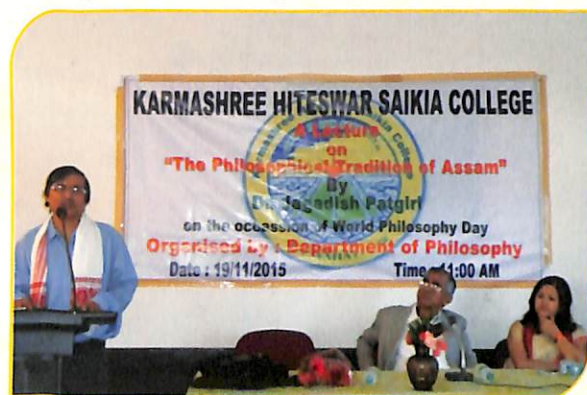

International Women's Day was celebrated on 9th March, 2015 in the college. On this occasion, the Women Study Centre of the



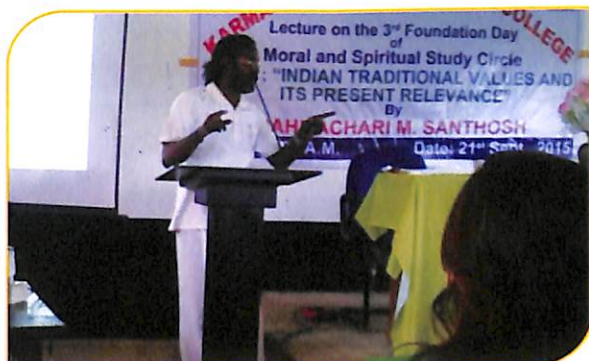

The Moral and Spiritual Study Circle, a registered society of the college, celebrated its foundation day on 21st September in the



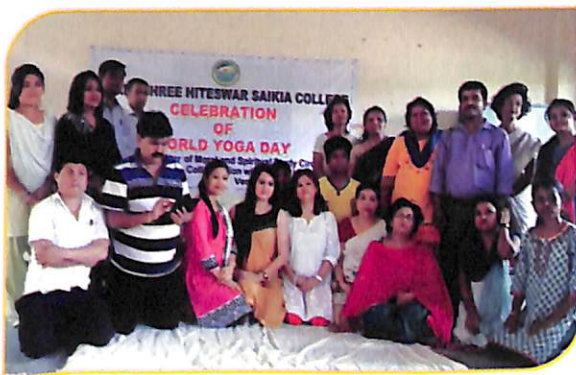

## ***Participation in the National Integration Day & International Yoga Day***

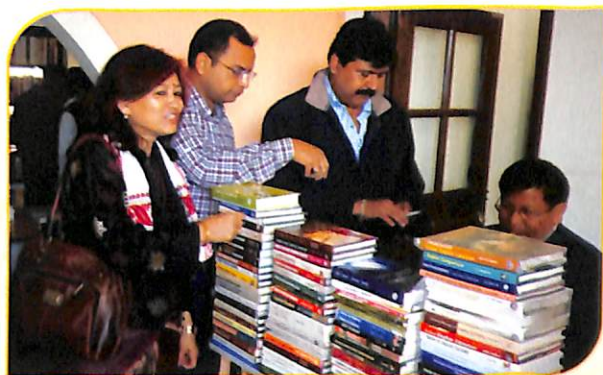
