The speaker also tried to connect the Balinese culture with India and Assam, in particular. A typical example she cited in this connection is that of the Bali culture. The lecture was further enriched by the deliberations of two other foreign scholars namely, Dr. Kanda Sakulthanasakdi Moore and Dr. Suartha Nyoman.

and the guests to the college. She said that the Bhutanese refugee problem also concerns North-East India since Bhutan is our neighbouring country. Talk on 'How to Avoid Accidents'


Teachers' Day

7. Handicraft Exhibition:


On 17th November, 2016 a Handicraft Exhibition was organized for the students where they showcased their creativity and talents through their artwork. The exhibition
