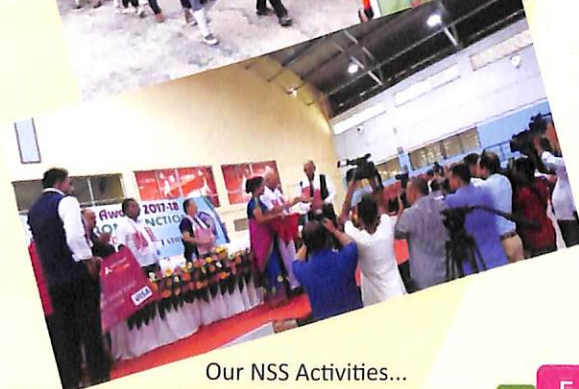
International Yoga Day

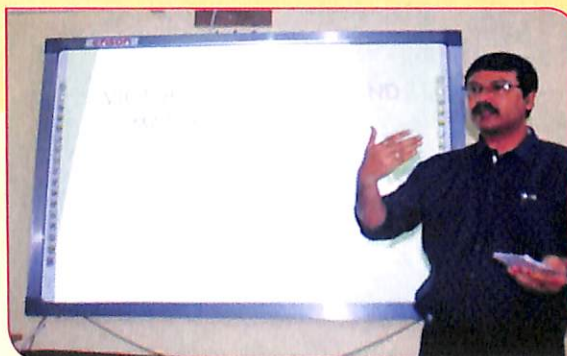
Department of English
