Events & Activities

STREET PLAY

NATIONAL SEMINAR

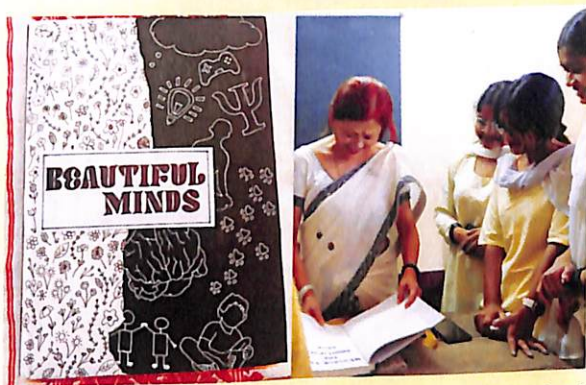
